

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-01

The following is a proposed ordinance. Comments shall be heard at the reading on March 31, 2026 at the Hamilton Lake Conservancy District office at 7405 S Wayne St. Hamilton, IN 46742 at 4:00 pm

This Ordinance is to AMEND Sections Five (5) and Ten (10) of Ordinance No. 2014-01 titled

RESTATED AND AMENDED SEWER RATE ORDINANCE, Dated 29th day of July, 2014.

WHEREAS, the purpose of Ordinance No 2026-01 is to add a Prohibited Discharge Standard, to Promulgate the Authority of the Hamilton Lake Conservancy District Board over Prohibited Discharges, and authority to impose fees for the pretreatment program.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Hamilton Lake Conservancy District Board:

Ordinance No. 2014-01, Section 5, Subsection (a) is Amended by adding a Subdivision (6), which reads “A. Petroleum, oil, non-biodegradable cutting oil or products of mineral oil origin in an amount that could pass through or cause interference with the operation and/or the performance of the POTW.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Hamilton Lake Conservancy District Board:

Ordinance No. 2014-01, Section 5 is Amended by adding Subsection (h), which reads “The Hamilton Lake Conservancy District Board has the legal authority to develop and enforce specific limits on prohibited substances that can be discharged into described waters or wastes to any public sewers described in Section 5, Subsection (a), Subdivisions (1) through (6).”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Hamilton Lake Conservancy District Board:

Ordinance No. 2014-01, Section 10 is Amended by adding Subsection (e), which reads, “The Hamilton Lake Conservancy District Board has the legal authority to impose fees to offset the costs incurred for administering the pretreatment program requirements.”

The invalidity of any added Subsection, Subdivision, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect any other Amended part of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from, and after passage and signed by the Hamilton Lake Conservancy District Board.
